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Teachers' Notes

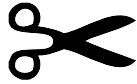
The instructions on each page contain symbols, so that students understand what they are being asked to do. Once you have explained what each symbol represents, the students should be able to complete all of the tasks independently.

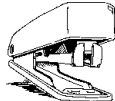

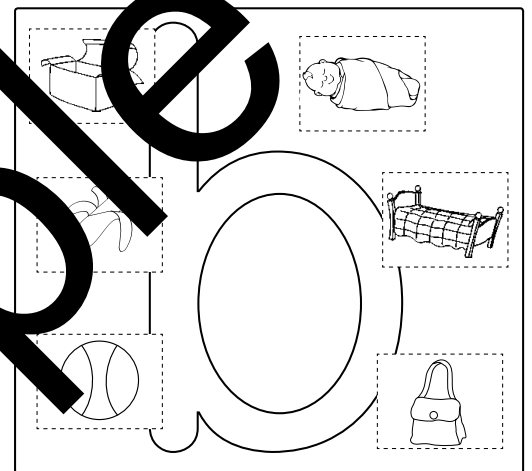

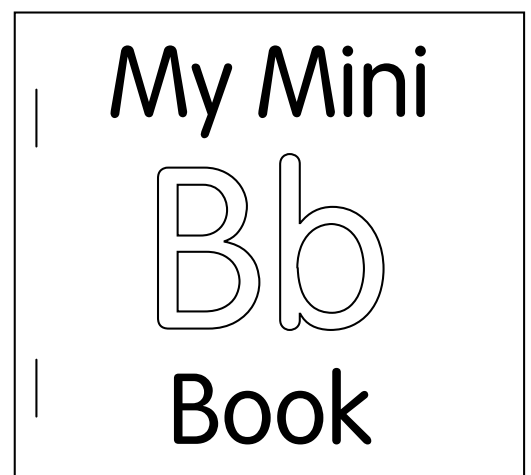
The students are repetitively asked to identify pictures that begin with a specific letter's sound, then cut and paste these pictures around a big letter. It may be useful to enlarge these sheets to A3 size. Additional activities using the big letter as a template are:

- cut and paste pictures from magazines around the big letter;
- write or cut and paste letters from magazines around the big letter;
- find words from around the classroom to write inside or around the big letter;
- use a combination of activities to create a group work poster of the big letter.



Students are frequently asked to make a mini book. This means that they are required to staple their sheets of paper together to create a little book that can be read to a friend, stuck into a workbook or sent home. Additional activities using the blank mini book as a template are:

- students create their own mini book based on the theme: ___ is for ___;
- create an alphabet book of known letters for each student. Add letters as they become known.
