1–100 Flashcards

Rhyming words

Select 10 random flashcards. Say a word that is not on these cards but will rhyme with one of them. Ask the child to find the rhyming flashcard word. Then ask them to think of another word that will also rhyme.

Pronouns

Select the flashcards that are pronouns and read them aloud. Tell the child that you want them to choose the pronoun card that will replace the noun in a sentence.

For example, say: "Look at the boy. Which flashcard word could be used in place of 'the boy'?" The child should select the flashcard with *him* on it, and say the new sentence: "Look at him."

Lucky dip

Children should play this game in pairs. Select 20 flashcards and place them in a container. Ask the first child to close their eyes, pick a card (without showing it to their partner) and read it aloud. They then ask their partner to spell the word and use it in a sentence. The pair then continues taking turns to choose a word to read out.

Illustrating sentences

Choose a flashcard and read the sentence on the back without showing the child. Ask the child to write the sentence and draw a picture to match it. Repeat with other flashcards.
