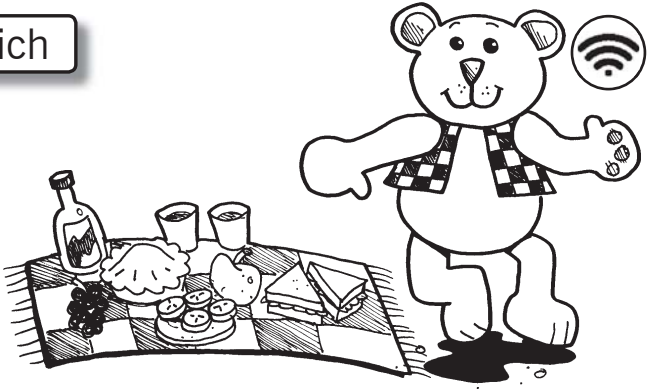

Read these stories and come up with answers to the problems.

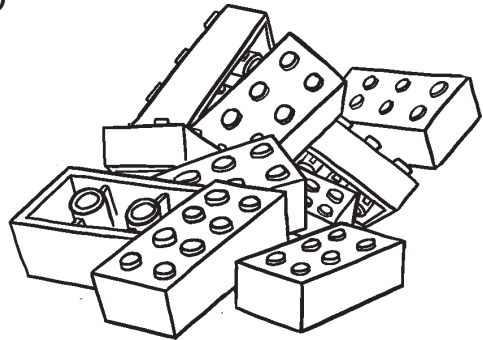
Story 1:
