The Sydney Harbour Bridge

The Sydney Harbour Bridge crosses Port Jackson in Sydney Harbour. It carries trains, vehicles, pedestrians and bicycles. The Sydney Harbour Bridge opened on 19 March 1932.

The Sydney Harbour Bridge is a steel single-arch bridge. It is 48.8 metres wide, making it the widest long-span bridge in the world. There are two tall pylons at each end of the bridge.

On New Year's Eve, the Sydney Harbour Bridge is the centre of an exciting fireworks display. Fireworks explode in brilliant colours from the arch, pylons and roadway.

Millions of tourists visit the Sydney Harbour Bridge each year. Tourists climb to the top of the bridge or visit the Pylon Lookout because of the magnificent views across Sydney.
