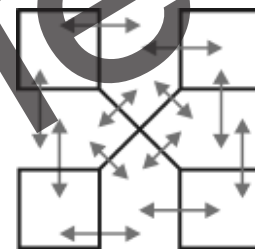
# Tile Search

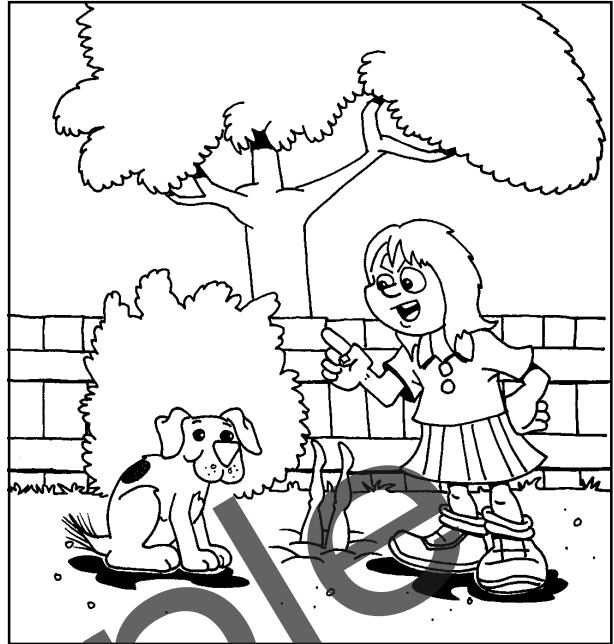
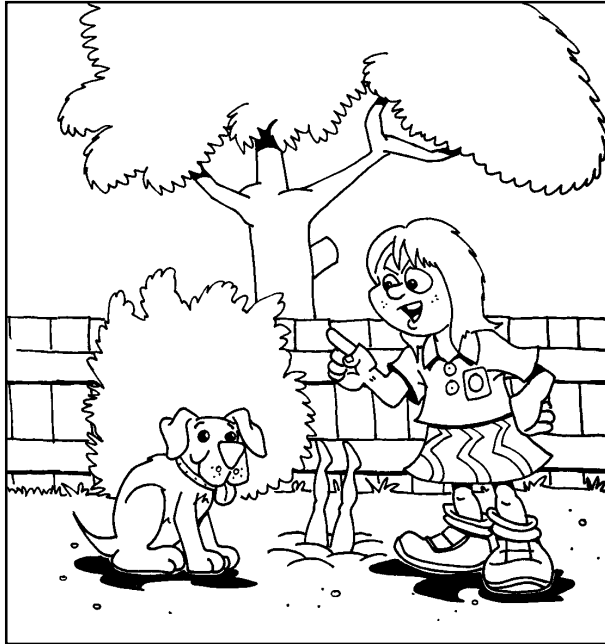
