

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Teachers' Notes

The instructions on each page contain symbols, so that students understand what they are being asked to do. Once you have explained what each symbol represents, the students should be able to complete all of the tasks independently.



For some activities, students will need a workbook or sheets of plain paper when completing the activities. They can paste the words/pictures that they have cut out, into their workbooks or onto plain sheets of paper. Each activity page is different, however below is an example of how a student could paste his/her cutting into a workbook. Alternatively, a teacher could have each part or parts, pre-cut and ready to use.

The Blend

1. Cut out the pictures and the blend "dr". Paste the pictures around the blend "dr" and label each picture.
2. Cut and paste the "Look, Say, Cover, Write and Check" into your workbook.
3. Write out each word three times.
4. Unjumble the "dr" words.

Mini Book: Sometimes students are asked to make a 'mini book'. This means that they are required to staple their sheets of paper together to create a little book that can be read to a friend, stuck into a workbook or sent home to read.






Flip Book: Sometimes students are asked to make a 'flip book'. This means that they are required to staple their sheets of paper together at the top left hand corner so that it can be flipped. Flip books can be stuck into a workbook, read to a friend or taken home to read for homework.
