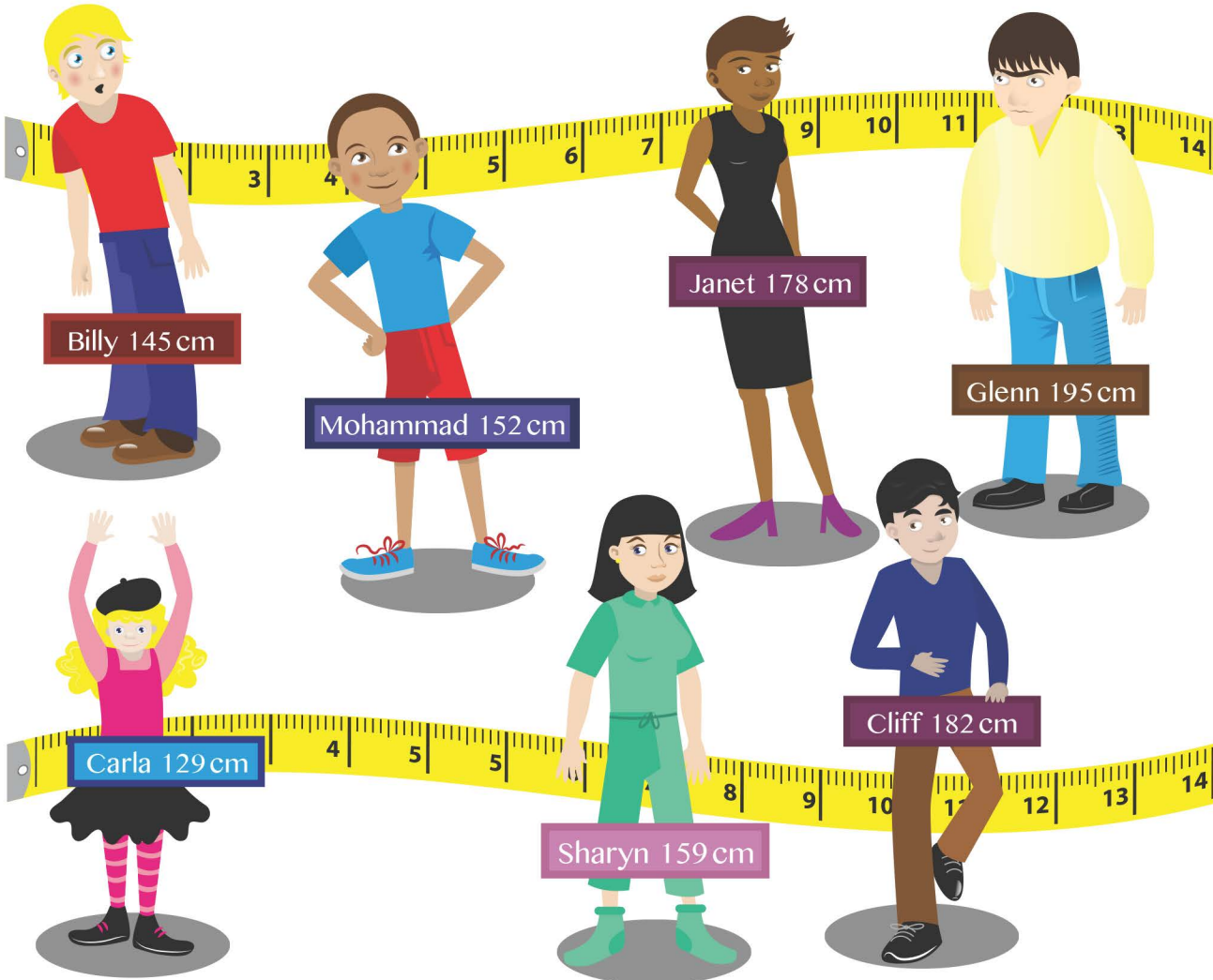


How tall am I?

Order the people below from tallest to shortest.



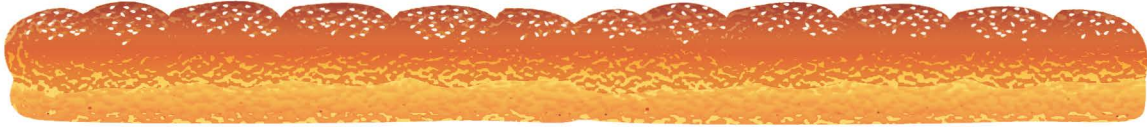

Break the bread



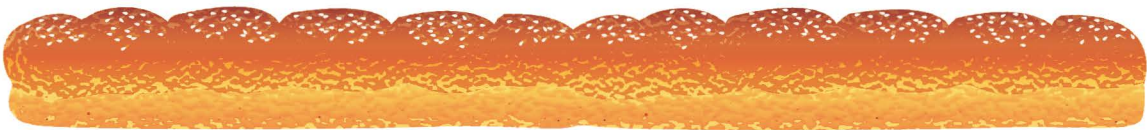
1. Cut the bread stick into quarters ($\frac{1}{4}$).

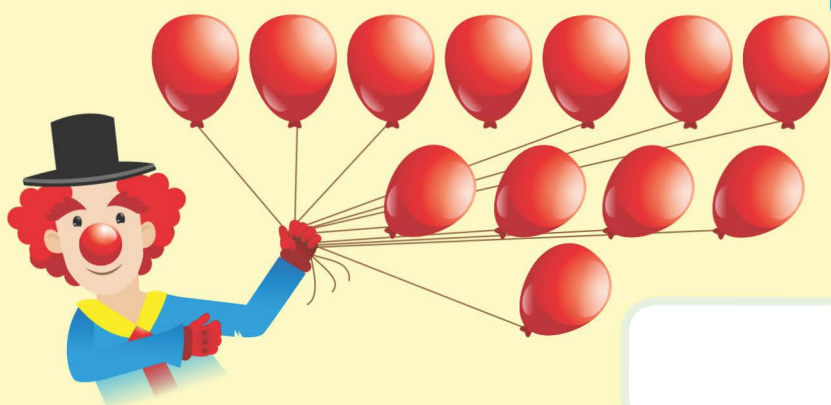
